Although analyses based on Euro-American conceptualizations of secrecy and knowledge were produced, they did not stack up with the ethnography in Bolivip. In Bolivip, "knowledge" implicates people in a double life by affording and bringing together divergent gendered perspectives: not so much revealing to a viewer their position in the composition of a field of knowledge, as newly revealing the composition of the knower and the subtleties of their personal capacities and relational supports.
