If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through class, cite it as an unpublished work. The rules for in-text citations will be the same. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation. For the works cited page of an unpublished manual, you can follow this format. Lastname, Firstname (or Department name).

### How do I cite a science lab manual for a report? - Ask Us!

Include the in-text citation on the References page. Begin with the name of the issuer of the manual, such as a company, a college department or an instructor. If it is an individual, list the last name, a comma and initials. Add a period. Insert the publication year within parentheses.
